Psalms 34:14

Hebrews 12:14

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord.

Galatians 5:16

Esther 2:11-12

Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of woman, (for so were the days of their purification accomplished, to wit, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with other things for the purification of the women.)

Also in the Old Testament, Exodus 30:30-32, Moses was commanded by God to tell the people that they will anoint the children of Israel with oil. In the New Testament, oil represents the Holy Ghost. We see that in the parable of the 10 virgins in Matthew 25:1-13. We also see in the book of Acts when the disciples received the Holy Ghost at Pentecost.

Acts 2:4

And they were filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

The purification of Esther is very symbolic of us today. We need to spend time with God and let him purify us to live a more holy life. For Esther and the other virgins it was twelve months to be ready for the king.
