

## Good vs Evil

The entire bible is based on good vs evil. All the way back from the fall, when satan deceived Eve in the garden of Eden, to Cain and Abel, Judas betraying Jesus, and the final battle of Armageddon. In God's entire universe and creation there is a spiritual battle that directly affects the physical. As believers we are always fighting against the flesh because satan and all his minions are always fighting to destroy the spirit.

Think of your body having an energy level on it. Not just energy as in you need a coffee but an energy of your spirit. When you're born it is at 100% because that's the way God made you. As you go through your life the spirit drops off more and more because you are living in the world and you get caught up in earthly wants and desires. Satan is always working to keep your energy down and away from God. The lower your spirit is pulled down, the more you lose focus on God. The Almighty can regenerate that spirit but first you need to make the choice for him to do that. He gave us free will so that we may choose and in doing so, may choose him. No soul is beyond reach for the Lord, but there will be a time in everyone's life when you realise that it's either up stairs or down stairs you're going.

That is the spiritual war, the battle for people's souls.

I myself have had dreams from the Lord that opened my eyes to an evil that cannot be described. To say that these things are wicked and evil is putting it lightly. I can't put into words the things I have seen in dreams because it has been such an evil type of creature or being that it's almost impossible to believe. They have been so evil that I could not look upon them. If people really knew where they were going without knowing Jesus Christ, they would not be turning away from our Lord and Saviour. I have also been shown the good as well. The Lord has shown me many things that I needed to fix and work on within myself and when you stop and listen to what the Holy Ghost is telling you, amazing things can happen.

The bible explains to us about the righteous and the wicked and how we can fight against this evil in the world. Here are some examples of the righteous and the wicked.

We see in the bible that there is a bride of Christ that will be raptured to heaven just before the tribulation starts, and we see in the book of Revelation there is a whore riding the beast which committed fornication with the kings of the earth.

The righteous and the wicked, the pure and defiled.

Ephesians 5:23-27

23

*For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.*

24

*Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing.*

25

*Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;*

26

*That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,*

27

*That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.*

Revelation 17:3-5

*And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters:*

*With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.*

*So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.*

*And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:*

*And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.*

These two comparisons of course are not a literal woman because the bride of Christ is the church, a body of people that God and Jesus has chosen to be his bride at the rapture and the whore is a global satanic system of ungodliness. This goes all the way back to the tower of Babel in Genesis chapter 11. Both of these represent a clear picture of how God will reward the righteous and punish the wicked.

The first time we see the word righteous in the bible is when God speaks to Noah and tells him how he has seen righteousness in his generation.

Genesis 7:1

*And the Lord said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation.*

Noah and his family were the only pure people left on earth before the flood. Everybody else was an evil, wicked person that had no love in their heart. This is why God destroyed the whole earth with a flood and saved only Noah and his family.

This brings me to the first time in the bible we see the word wicked used. In about 1656 or 2344 BC the earth was filling up with people. Numbers were increasing and the wickedness of humans were great.

Generations were defiled and many were not completely human beings anymore. The fallen angels that sinned and rebelled against God had left a bloodline of evil man that was creating hybrid humans. The giants spoken of in these next verses here were descendants of the fallen angels. They had manipulated the DNA of God's creation and multiplied that through the whole earth.

Genesis 6:4-5

*There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were old, men of renown.*

*And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.*

When Jesus spoke to the people about his return, it wasn't just a bunch of stories quoting the Old Testament. He spoke of the days of Noah and the flood for a reason. In that time people were evil and they committed very sinful acts. DNA was being manipulated back then and it is starting to be manipulated throughout the whole world right now. If anything ever changes, modifies, or clones your DNA, it is there permanently and can never be changed back to normal. Once that change happens, it also means that you are technically no longer human the way God has made you.

Matthew 24:37

*But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.*

What else happened in the days of Noah? God saved him and his family from the flood. This is the same for the rapture of the church of Christ. We as believers will be raptured and saved from the destruction of the tribulation.

So where else in the word of God do we see examples of the righteous and the wicked? If we have a look in the book of Revelation, we will see that there are two white horses that appear. A white horse that comes out at the start of the tribulation with its rider carrying a bow and conquering the world. The other is a white horse at the end of the tribulation who's rider is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war.

So who are these two horses and who are their riders?

Revelation 6:2

*And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering and to conquer.*

This horseman is non other than the antichrist. This man is in the world right now as you read this and properly working at the United Nations somewhere. He cannot reveal himself until after the rapture and the first seal is broken.

This is another reason why people need to believe the scripture when talking about if it is a pre-tribulation rapture or not. The first seal opened by the Lamb cannot be opened until the tribulation starts, so therefore the antichrist cannot reveal himself until the tribulation begins. John was raptured to heaven in chapter four of Revelation before the seals were opened, to witness these things which will come to pass.

So who is the white horse and his rider at the end of the tribulation?

You guessed it, it's Jesus coming back to earth.

Revelation 19:11

*And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.*

This is one of my favourite verses in the whole bible because this is the time when Jesus will return to destroy the wicked, the ungodly, and all that stands against God. No weapon or technology will be able to fight against Jesus Christ at his return. This is also the time when the people that were raptured come back with him at this battle of Armageddon. The next verse is connected to the people that were raptured before the tribulation began.

Revelation 19:14

*And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.*

To fully understand this you need to know the Jewish wedding traditions. When a man was to be married, his father would pick a virgin bride for him. The father would send out trusted servants ( Holy Spirit ) to find his son's bride. The father ( God ) would choose a bride ( church ) for the bridegroom ( Jesus ) that's best suited for him. The bridegroom would have to pay a price for his bride. This was paid on the cross when Jesus died for our sins. He paid it in blood. There would then be a contract done up to bind the bride and bridegroom so that it cannot be broken. It would need a witness to this contract and then sealed until a time when the father so chooses. John was that witness when he was taken to heaven and shown the seals being sealed, after Jesus the Lamb was slain. When the father has picked the right time and tells his son the bridegroom to go get his bride, the bridegroom and bride would then go away for 7 days ( 7 years tribulation ) and then return for the marriage ceremony and supper.

This is what it will be like for the people raptured and then return with Jesus at Armageddon. We are returning to complete the marriage ceremony at the supper.

Revelation 19:9

*And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb.*

In the very near future, Jesus is going to return for his bride and in a twinkling of an eye, millions of people will just disappear. In that moment I pray you will not be discouraged because the Lord God Almighty will have a purpose for you on earth journeying that tribulation period. If you are reading this in that time period, then you will know how to help other people understand that their loved ones are in heaven.

No matter the trials and tribulation that we face in life, God is always with us and these next verses are amazing verses to strengthen you in what ever trouble you're going through.

Isaiah 41:10

*Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.*

Galatians 5:5

*For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteous by faith.*

Ephesians 6:16

*Above all, taking the Shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.*

Until Jesus comes back to earth and destroys the wicked, things will just get worse and worse, but in Christ Jesus through the Holy Spirit you can have peace, no matter the storm around you. There is no man, no demon, no being more powerful, more perfect and more righteous than our Lord Jesus Christ.

He can do all things, and all things will be done for those who believe.
